## Summary WP.COM Site Setup Tips (Self-Help)\*

Clicking the WP.COM "Get Started" button can take only 10-15 min, but take your time!

So **BEFORE** you click "Get Started", do the following:

- Plan: Plan basic site purpose and content do Site outline/sketch (on paper or PC!)
- **Site Address:** Think about your site URL –short, descriptive, memorable.
- Theme Exploration: Check out available Themes on WP.COM (300+ to choose from!)
- **Password:** Have a strong Password ready
- **Migration:** *If an old, existing site,* plan what content to migrate to new WP.COM site, and how to Import/Export content. Check if need migration tool if old site not WP. *If no old site,* select what content to copy from PC, and/or what new content to do for site.

**AFTER** you click "Get Started" (during sign-up with 3 Steps, and a total of 5 Questions):

- **Email:** Enter your correct email you'll need it later to activate the site.
- "Free"!: When asked about type site or Plan, always look to mark "free"

## **LATER** once your site is set up:

- **Privacy Settings:** On your Left column of Actions (Dashboard), click lower down on Settings/General/Privacy initially mark this as "Private" (so no spam!). When you start testing your site, you can edit this to "Hidden" (accessible on Web, but no Search engines!).....and when ready for final "Launch" to your audience, mark this area "Public" (so Search engines are able to track you).
- **Test Site:** Do another site for test purposes from within your Dashboard.
- **Reader Tab:** The other "Reader" tab (upper left on your Dashboard) is to get WP.COM blog news, and to search or follow other bloggers within the WP.COM community.
- **Set up two Tabs on your PC:** one for Dashboard actions, and another to view impact of site edits and additions. Remember to refresh screen to view your updated site.
- Saving and Updating your Content: As you start putting content on your WP.COM site, take care to click the buttons "Update" or "Publish" frequently to save your work. Sometimes edits are saved automatically if no such button present.
- How Many Blogs?: Don't create more blogs than you need to (although no limit).

## Get **SUPPORT** for your Site:

- **Knowledge Base and Forum:** Search the WP.COM Knowledge Base if any questions, or post a query to a WP.COM Forum for other user tips.
- **Google Search:** As you become more knowledgeable, you might also get in the habit of occasionally asking any WP questions of Google on the Web.
