From <u>within</u> Firefox (50.0.1) you can access a complete list, explanation, and automatic initiation of most Firefox features by simply clicking on the GETTING STARTED Icon (on the Bookmark Toolbar). This includes the following major topics:

Bookmark a website

Find everything with the Awesome Bar

Private Browsing

Customize the menu or the toolbar

Add features to Firefox with add-ons

Get Help
