## Why Link?



- Move content from phone to computer
  - Pictures
  - Notifications/Messages
    - Two Factor Authentications
- Phone/Message (SMS) from computer

## How to Link



- Microsoft Store & Google Play App
  - MS Your Phone Companion
  - Google Link To Windows
  - Android Version 7.0 or Higher

## Steps



- Windows 10/11 Computer
  - Go To Settings
  - Select Phone
  - Click Add A Phone
    - Confirm Microsoft Account (if prompted)
    - Click button to Link Phone
    - Type number for Android Phone
    - Click Send

You should receive a text on phone with a link to install the *Your Phone Companion app . . .* 

## Steps (Continued)



### On Android Phone

- Click the text link provided
- Install Google Your Phone App
- Open App and sign in with your Microsoft Account
- Allow send and view SMS messages
- Allow app to make and manage phone calls
- Allow access to contacts







